Supporting Programs for Youth

- Employees from Cargill Pork's facility in Glenwood have partnered with the Pike County 4-H Club on various programs including workforce preparation programs, environmental awareness efforts and community clean-up activities.
- In Ozark, Cargill provided funding for youth recreation programs including new baseball fields, pitching machines for girls' softball, and the Ozark High School basketball program.
- Cargill is a leading sponsor of Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, having contributed more than \$1.2 million nationwide since 1992. Cargill employees and businesses participate in farm safety activities in several Arkansas communities.

Improving Quality of Life

- Cargill in Russellville actively promotes water preservation and conservation efforts through a variety of Water Matters programs, including Adopt A Highway clean up projects, nature trail renovations and environmental-education projects at local schools.
- Cargill facilities in Glenwood, Russellville, Springdale and Umpire have been designated Groundwater Guardians by the National Groundwater Foundation for efforts to educate the community on water conservation and preservation.
- The Northwest Arkansas Food bank honored Cargill and Honeysuckle White with a *One in a Million Award* for their continuing efforts to help feed the hungry.
- In the last five years, Cargill employees and facilities, along with corporate support, have contributed nearly \$150,000 to United Ways in Arkansas.
- Cargill hosted a fundraiser for St. Francis House in Springdale, a community clinic that provides medical, dental and optometric care.

Supporting Education

- Since 2000, Cargill has awarded scholarships to more than 45 college-bound Arkansas youth.
