Supporting Programs for Youth

- Contributions from Cargill helped build new playgrounds at city parks in Lafayette.
- Cargill is a leading sponsor of Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, having contributed more than \$1.2 million nationwide since 1992. Cargill employees and businesses participate in farm safety activities in several Indiana communities.
- Cargill's Mentone facility has supported local youth participation in county 4-H competitions.
- Cargill helps sponsor the Science Olympiad Team from Thomas Jefferson Middle School in Valparaiso to attend the national competition.
- Cargill in Lafayette supports the education and preservation program at Wildcat Wildlife Center.

Improving Quality of Life

- Cargill helped support the Lafayette Transitional Housing Center, which provides case management and housing services to thousands of homeless people in Tippecanoe County.
- The Tipton County Soil and Water Conservation District received a grant from Cargill to conduct a three-year water-quality assessment of various streams in the county.
- Cargill AgHorizons donated \$18,000 to the town of Wheatfield to drill wells so the local fire department has direct access to water.
- Cargill has funded fire and rescue programs in Dana, Lafayette, Linden, Mentone and Wheatfield.
- Cargill was instrumental in providing funding to form the Pulaski County YMCA.
- Cargill employees have helped build 16 homes for low-income families with Habitat for Humanity in Lafayette, Evansville, Princeton and Vincennes.
- In the last five years, Cargill and its employees have donated more than \$300,000 to local United Ways in Indiana, supporting hundreds of health and human service organizations.

Supporting Education

- Cargill has contributed more than \$275,000 to academic programs in business and technology at Purdue University and the University of Notre Dame through the Cargill Higher Education Initiative.
- Cargill has awarded 75 scholarships to college-bound Indiana youth in the last five years.
- Cargill businesses helped the Indiana Soybean Board continue its Soybean Science Kit program for 91,000 students across the state.
