Supporting Programs for Youth

- Cargill’s businesses in Kansas City help support youth participating in Operation Breakthrough by providing funding for summer enrichment, arts education and literacy activities.
- In Dodge City, Cargill helped establish a Boys and Girls Club.
- Cargill is a leading sponsor of Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, having contributed more than \$1.2 million nationwide since 1992. Cargill employees and businesses participate in farm safety activities in several Kansas communities.
- Exploration Place, the science museum in Wichita that serves children and families throughout Kansas, received \$250,000 from Cargill.
- The YMCA Children’s Program in Wichita received funds to start a *Partnership with Youth* program.

- Cargill contributed \$850,000 to the Kansas Foodbank Warehouse to help it build a new facility in Wichita to enhance its ability to help address hunger throughout the state.
- Cargill employees in Kansas City, McPherson, Dodge City, Hutchinson and Wichita participate in Cargill’s *Water Matters* program to help teach children about water conservation and preservation.
- Cargill is working with the Kansas City School District to provide the Science Screen Report to help students improve science and technology skills.
- Cargill Meat Solutions was selected by the National Conference for Community and Justice for the Community and Justice Award for its commitment to diversity.
- Cargill donated \$750,000 to the Sedgwick County Zoo for the Cargill Learning Center.
- Cargill donated \$25,000 to the Salvation Army’s new community center in Hutchinson.
- In the last five years, Cargill and its employees throughout Kansas have donated nearly \$3 million to United Ways across the states. Cargill’s businesses in Wichita received the *Spirit of Caring* award for their outstanding United Way campaign.
- Cargill established a Community Action Panel in Dodge City with its community leaders to discuss local issues.

Supporting Education

- Cargill has contributed more than \$2 million to Kansas State University, including \$1 million for the Grain Science and Industry Complex in the College of Agriculture. Cargill and K-State have worked together on targeted academic programs in the agriculture and engineering colleges for more than 20 years.
- Cargill businesses in Wichita provided funding to an innovation program called AVID to help students achieve success in school by offering mentoring, tutors and special education.
- Dodge City High School built a new agriculture building with support from Cargill.
- In the last five years, Cargill has awarded scholarships to more than 200 college-bound Kansas youth.
