Improving Quality of Life

- Cargill's ongoing commitment to California and surrounding communities includes volunteering with local youth organizations, funding for local library renovations, donating food for local events, participating in local 4-H youth activities and judging for the state fair.
- The Salt Fork YMCA in Marshall received \$55,000 from Cargill for its capital campaign.
- In Forest City, Cargill funds were used to help establish a new 911 system for area residents.
- Cargill and the South Central Pork Producers Association and the Moreau Fire Protection District to develop an Environmental Response Unit and provide environmental emergency prevention information to livestock producers.
- Cargill businesses and employees have contributed more than \$250,000 in the last five years to United Ways in Missouri, supporting hundreds of local health and human service organizations.

Supporting Programs for Youth

- Marshall Public Schools received funding from Cargill to help build a new athletic stadium.
- In California, Cargill's community-wide effort with California Progress, Inc., has helped build a new youth center, soccer field and volleyball courts.
- Since 1995, Cargill has awarded more than \$189,000 in scholarships to 169 college-bound Missouri youth.
