### **Supporting Programs for Youth**

- Cargill is a leading sponsor of Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, having contributed more than \$1.2 million nationwide since 1992. Cargill employees and businesses participate in farm safety activities in several Nebraska communities.
- Cargill employees have been honored with the Cargill Cares Volunteer Award for their individual work with youth organizations such as Little League, Boy Scouts, Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, American Red Cross and the Groundwater Children's Festival.

### **Improving Quality of Life**

- Cargill donated \$250,000 to the Alegant Health Memorial Hospital in Schuyler for a new community health library.

- Cargill's facility in Nebraska City donated land and financial assistance for the Historic Depot Place to provide area residents a multi-use community center.
- In the last five years, Cargill and its employees have donated more than \$1 million to local United Ways across Nebraska.
- Cargill has provided significant capital in Blair to support organizations such as 4-H, Memorial Community Hospital, Blair Family YMCA, and Groundwater Guardian.

### **Supporting Education**

- Cargill's beef plant in Schuyler helped fund the special education program at Schuyler Central High School and provided funding for two additional teachers at the Schuyler Grade School.
- Gibbon schools received funds and volunteers from Cargill for its reading program.
- Cargill employees in Blair teach local school children about water conservation and preservation through classroom visits, tours of Cargill's wastewater treatment facility and by participating in the annual Nebraska Groundwater Festival in Grand Island.
- Cargill has awarded scholarships to more than 150 college-bound youth from Nebraska.
- Cargill sponsored two Nebraska teachers for the Keystone Science Center in Colorado where they learned creative ways to explore environmental issues with their students.
