### **Supporting Programs for Youth**

- Cargill and its employees support and participate in the annual Children's Water Festival in Dayton to educate Ohio youth about the importance of protecting water resources.
- Cargill has supported 4-H Healthy Lifestyles grants in three communities in the last two years.
- Cargill provided financial support in Dayton for a new building for the Boy Scouts and a new trail system for the Girls Scouts.
