Supporting Programs for Youth

- Cargill has contributed to the Texas 4-H Development Foundation to help build hands-on ag-educational facilities for Texas youth and support the Texas 4-H Horse Show.
- Cargill has awarded close to \$400,000 in scholarships to more than 350 college-bound Texas youth.
- In Dalhart Cargill joined with Dalla-Hartley Youth to offer after-school programs for students.
- Cargill is a leading sponsor of Farm Safety 4 Just Kids, having contributed more than \$1.2 million nationwide since 1992. Cargill employees and businesses participate in farm safety activities in several Texas communities.
- Cargill employees, using funds from Cargill's *Water Matters* program and an internal recycling program, partner with a new Saginaw school each year to teach youth about water preservation and conservation.

Improving Quality of Life

- Cargill donated \$15,000 to the Bovina Community Network to help support the organization's program to provide area residents access to technology through computers.
- Cargill donated \$50,000 to Southwest Center for Performing Arts in Amarillo.
- Cargill and the city of Friona joined together to create a community park at Reeve's Lake.
- Cargill contributed more than \$150,000 to local fire and rescue programs, hospitals, clinics and EMT facilities in many Texas communities, including Channelview, Friona, Hart, Spearman and Waco.
- The train depot in Saginaw was restored into a community center with funding from Cargill.
- Horizon Milling in Galena Park makes regular donations to the Houston Food Bank and supported the Texas Day of Nutrition in 2004.
- In the last five years, Cargill employees have raised more than \$1 million for Texas United Ways.

Supporting Education

- Since 1997, Cargill has awarded more than \$400,000 to the School of Business at the University of Texas-Austin for diversity recruitment, an International Fellows program, Information Systems curriculum development, and a resource library in the new state-of-the-art Career Placement Center.
- Cargill contributed nearly \$200,000 to Texas A&M for various scholarship and fellowship programs.
- In Seguin, Cargill donated funds to the AgriFood Education Council for local youth agribusiness education programs.
- Cargill donated funds to help Bovina schools purchase computers for students.
- Cargill sponsors and works with two teachers from Texas in their classrooms for an environmental-education training program, to promote environmental stewardship and hands-on learning.
