Keeping it clean

Consumers are increasingly seeking to avoid or reduce additives in their diet so demand for natural colours and flavours is booming. In the quest to avoid e-numbers, companies are increasingly using real fruit and plant extracts to provide natural colouring. To reassure consumers, the claim 'made with real fruit/vegetables' is increasingly common on packaging.

Looking at emulsifiers, sunflower lecithin is on the rise – being perceived as cleaner and healthier. Taking this a step further, some manufacturers are removing lecithin completely from their cocoa and chocolate products.

Responding to the clear label trend, organic cocoa and chocolate products, seen as more healthy and natural, are continuing to increase in popularity particularly in Germany, France and the UK. Organic ingredients are also permeating a growing range of categories, with the biggest growth expected to be in chocolate confectionery and ice cream.
