# Soy sourcing and traceability data

**Cargill is committed to transforming our supply chains globally to be deforestation-free by 2030 while protecting native vegetation beyond forests.**

Our work with the Soft Commodities Forum supports this company commitment. To achieve our goal of becoming deforestation- and conversion-free, we need to increase traceability, which is why we have been investing heavily in the process of mapping our supply chain.

This work is a meaningful undertaking given we have thousands of suppliers in the region. We reached our goal of having 100% of the Brazil supply chain mapped with georeferenced single points, six months ahead of schedule.
