Invoicing Transition	 Transition: Invoicing Converted Orders Invoicing can be done using the new purchase order number in the Ariba network The Cargill project team will provide a cross-reference of the old to new Purchase Order numbers
Orders Pending Invoicing	 The Cargill project team is actively reaching out to Suppliers to complete pending invoicing via Ariba At the time of Go Live, orders which have not been invoiced through the network will be communicated by the Cargill Invoices not posted by Go Live will need to be submitted by e-mail The Cargill project team will communicate purchase orders where Ariba invoicing was not completed, and invoicing will need to be completed by e-mail Please e-mail Invoices to CargillFSC AccountsPayable@cargill.com

Purchase Order Confirmations	 For Material Ariba Purchase Orders received through Ariba, the order confirmations should be created in the network. Post order confirmation, you can proceed to submit the invoice in Ariba. 				
Invoicing	 Invoicing Through Ariba Network Purchase Orders received through Ariba network should be invoiced in Ariba Network only. Invoices submitted manually for Ariba purchase orders will be rejected by Cargill. Order confirmation must match Cargill's purchase order to ensure prompt and accurate payment. 				
	 Purchase Orders Received Outside of Ariba: Please continue to submit invoices to accounts payable. You can visit NA - Supplier Invoicing for additional information. 				
Support	 Suppliers should use the <u>Cargill - Ariba Master guide</u> (link to PDF) to understand the business processes required by Cargill via the Ariba Network.
